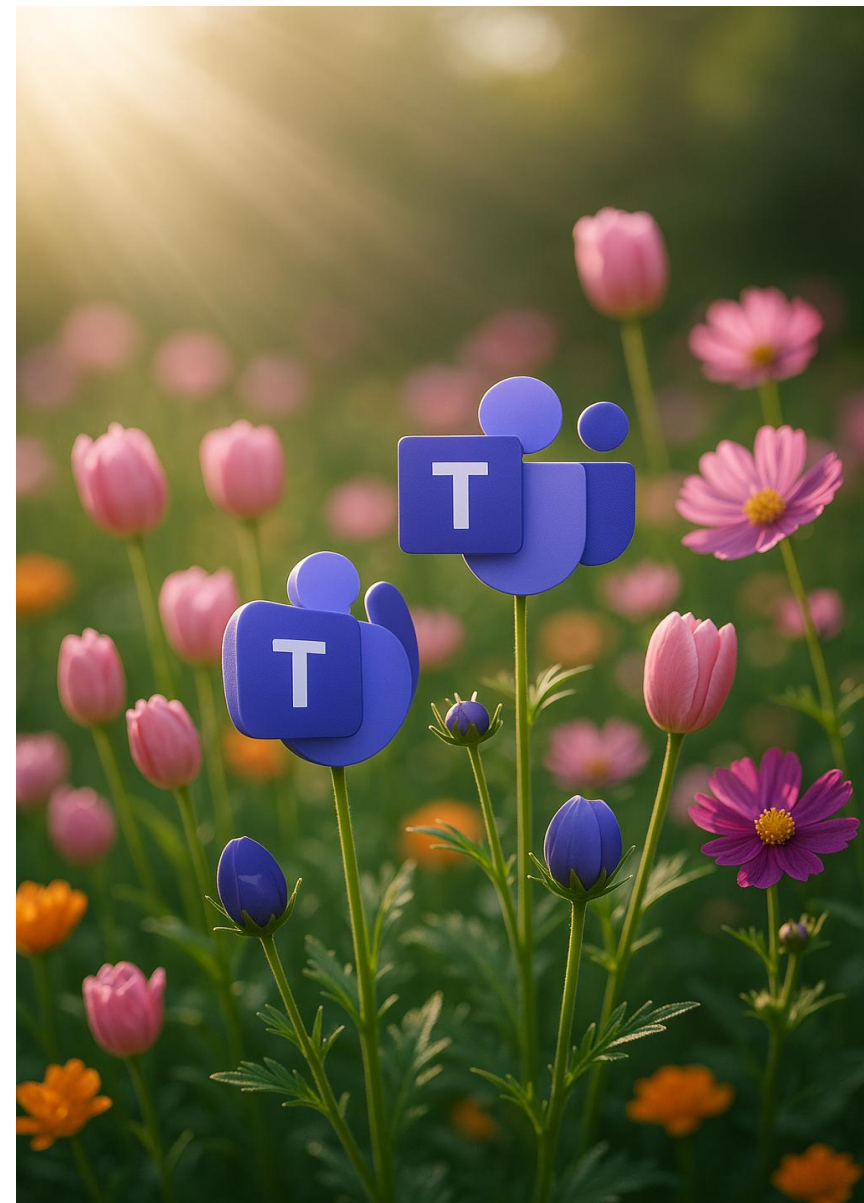

Drivers for Teams Phone

- **Existing phone systems need upgrades**
“We basically needed to overhaul everything, and the cost of doing that just for the Avaya system was why we started looking at other systems.”
- **WFH has made desk phones irrelevant**
“How do you route calls from our on-premises phone system to people who are working remotely?”
- **Telecom requirements have changed**
“40% of our employees said they don’t need (want) a phone”
- **Getting more for less**
“It's obviously critical to get the most out of our investments. There's no really better example of that than the E5 license from Microsoft.”

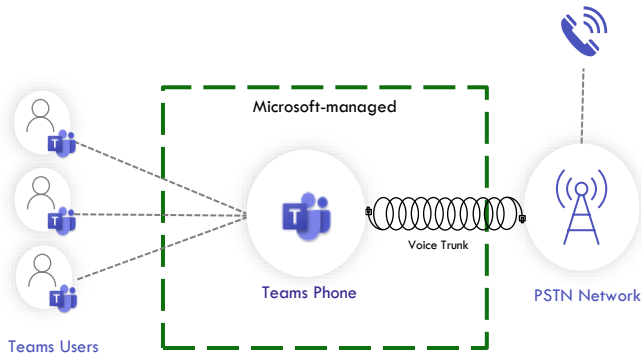

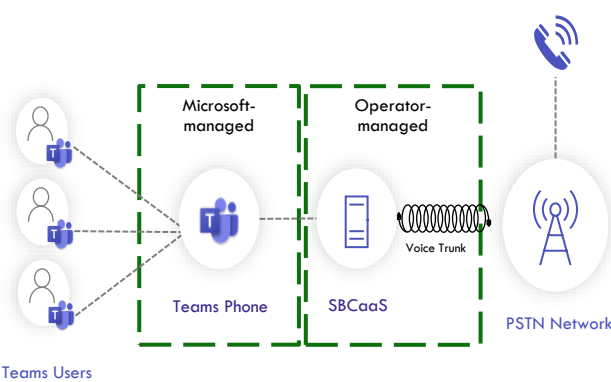
Microsoft Teams Calling Plans

A fast and Simple way to setup calling without additional technical configurations. Microsoft hosts call control and PSTN trunks.



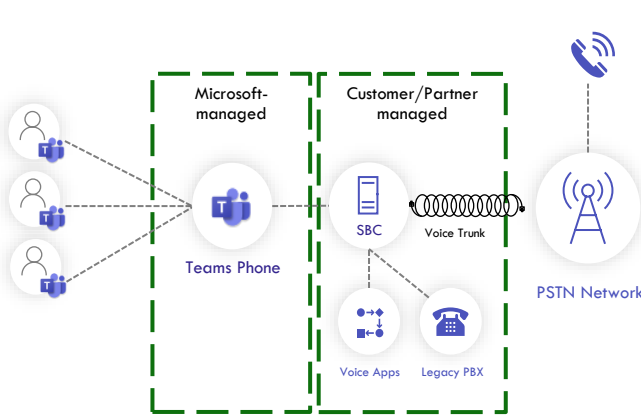
Operator Connect

A quick and easy way to integrate with calling while maintaining existing service. Microsoft hosts call control while 3rd party provides PSTN trunks.

Highly customizable where Microsoft hosts call control and PSTN trunks terminate locally into SBC.

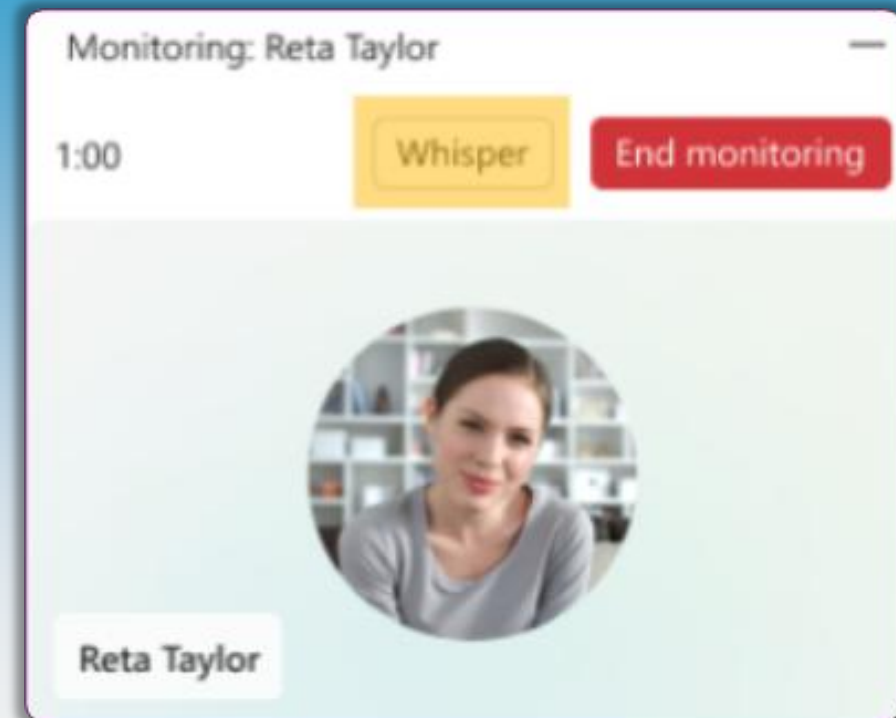
Queues App: Barge/Whisper/Monitor/Takeover

 Available in public preview in April

Help team leads and supervisors manage and train junior agents effectively.

This feature allows supervisors to:

- **Monitor:** Listen to the conversations their agents are having with callers without being heard.
- **Whisper:** Provide assistance to agents during a call without the caller hearing.
- **Barge:** Join a call in progress to assist both the agent and the caller.
- **Takeover:** Remove an agent from a call and take over the conversation, if necessary.

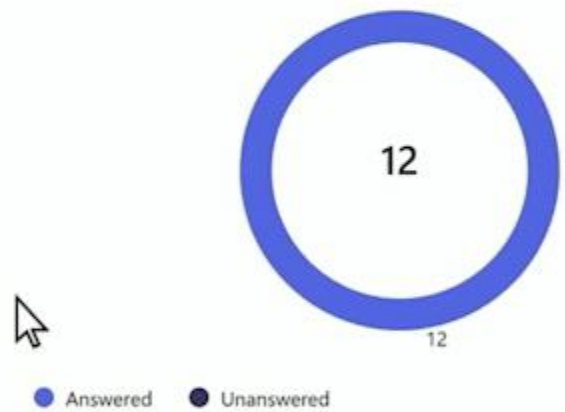

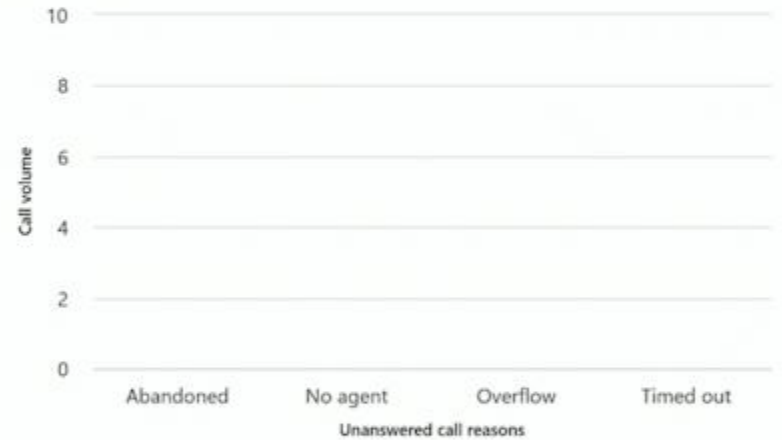

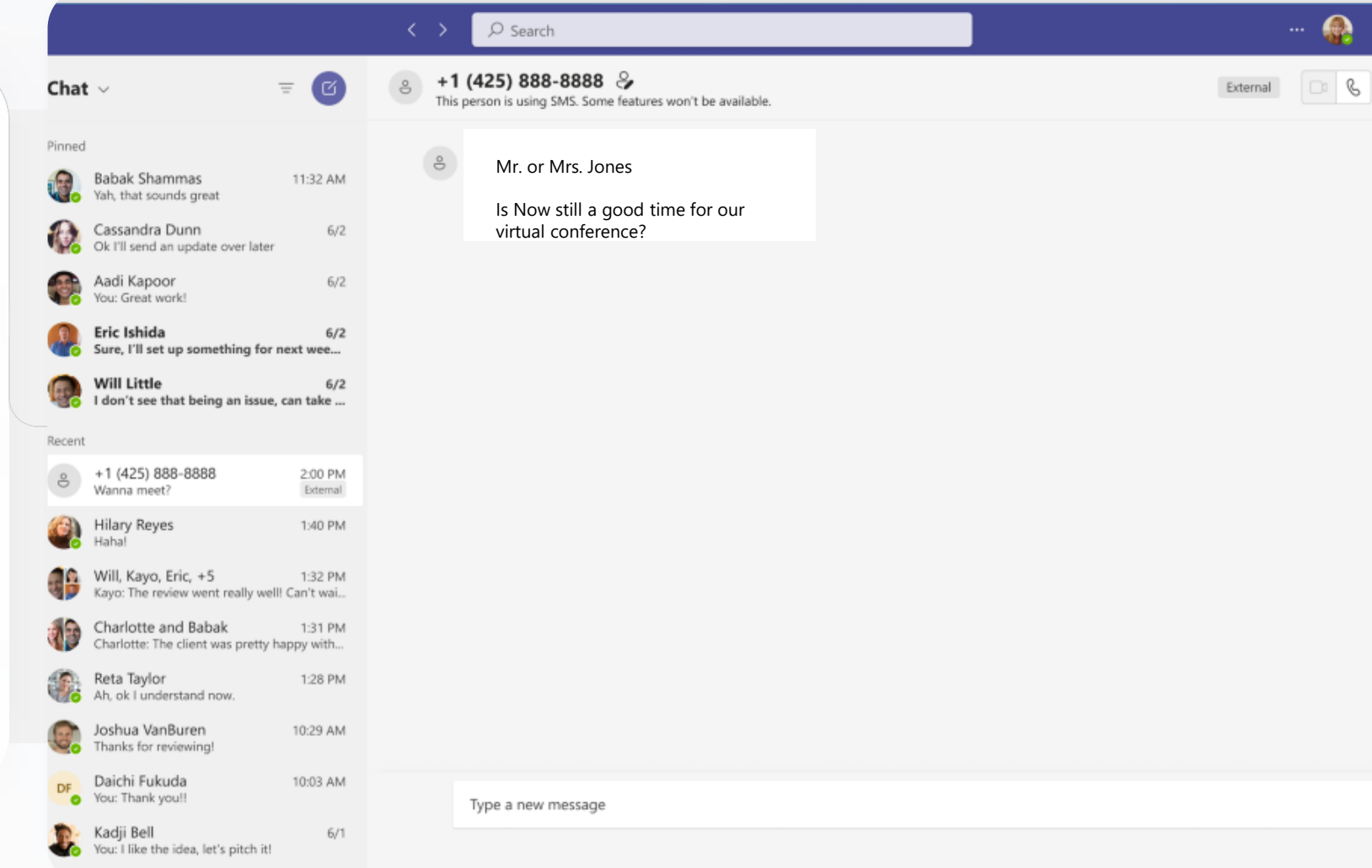
SMS to DID Numbers

SMS is fully integrated in the Teams messaging experience.

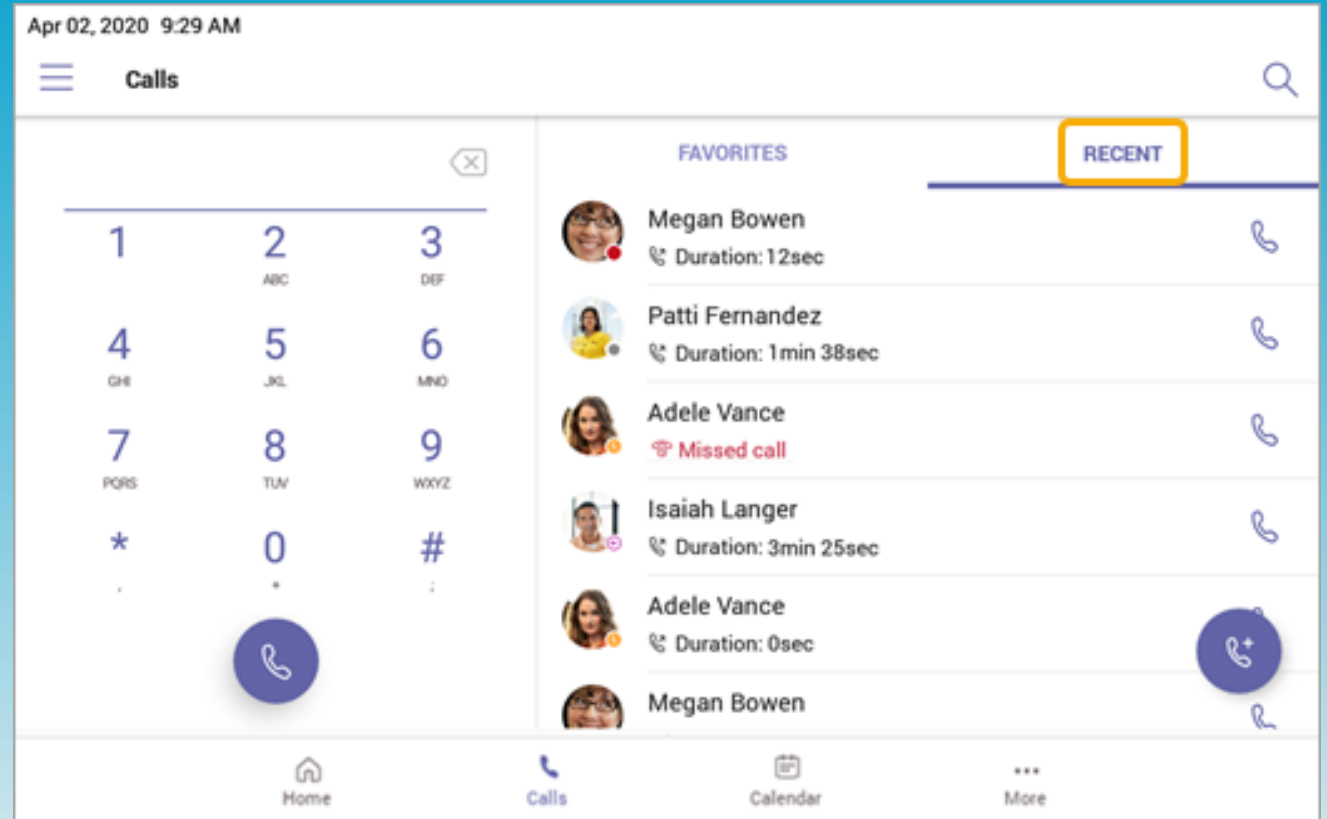

This feature allows delegates to view and manage calls made or received on behalf of the delegator, ensuring seamless communication and collaboration.

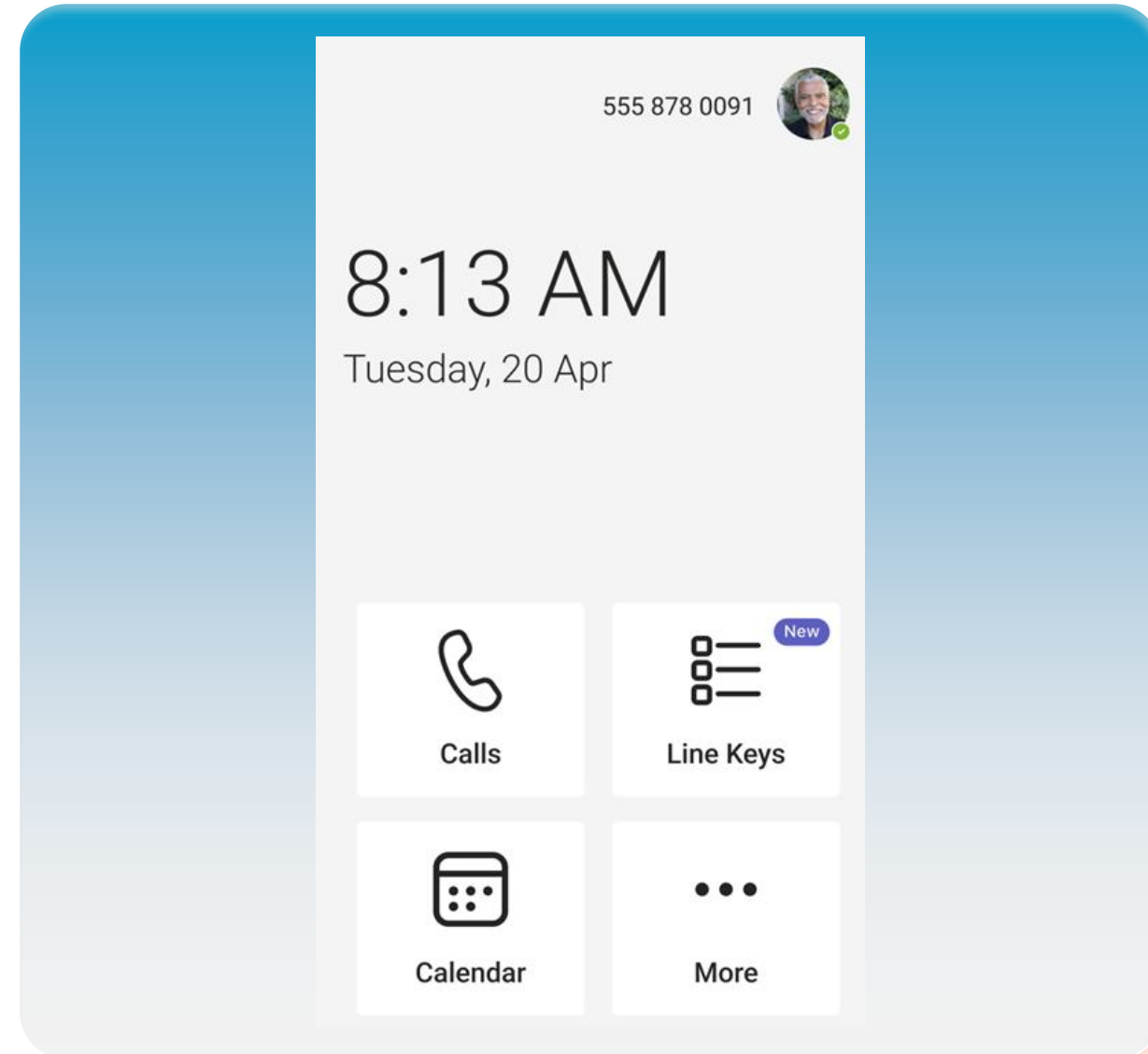
Phone Devices: Line Keys On Phone Devices With Touch Screens

They enable one-touch dialing capabilities, making it easier to quickly access frequently dialed contacts and improve productivity.



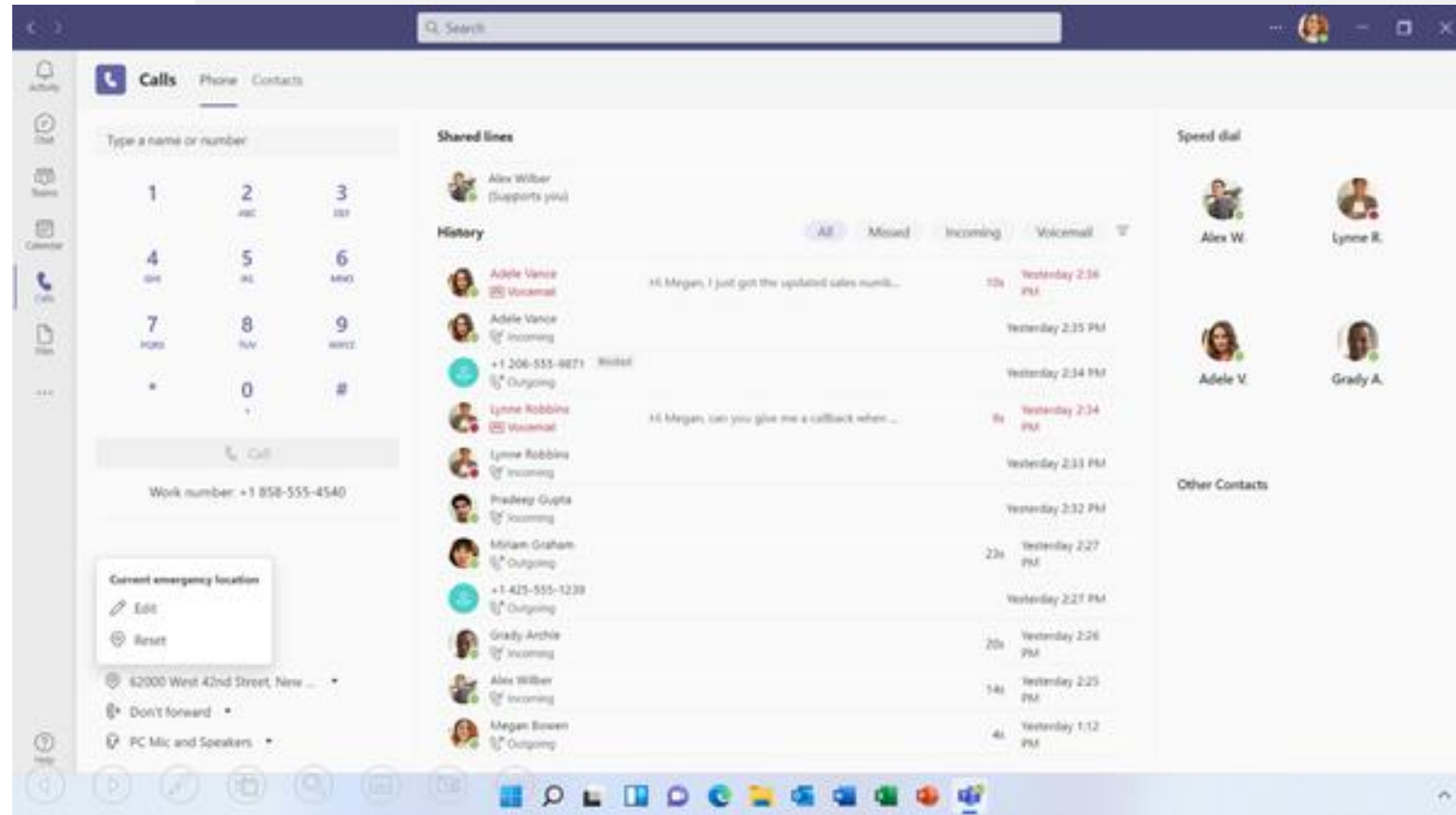
Dynamic Emergency Calling

 Secure, reliable, and simple to manage

Dynamic Emergency:

Set your emergency location in the Calls app on Teams with location recommendations.

New enhancement, the ability to set the emergency location on your Teams Phone devices without the need to rely on administrators to set the location.

Emergency Protocol Success

1. Alert all staff and security rapidly – regardless of location
2. Provide eyes and accountability outside for responders outside of the office
3. Allow staff to enact emergency procedures more rapidly
4. Protection and expeditious vital information to aid emergency responders
5. **e911** support and administrative processes

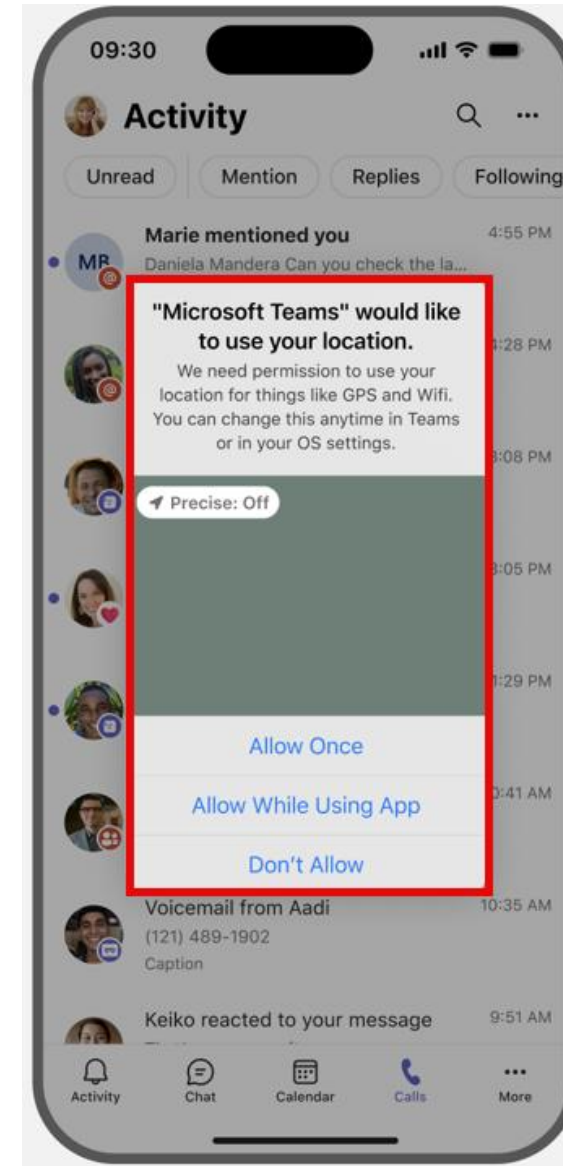

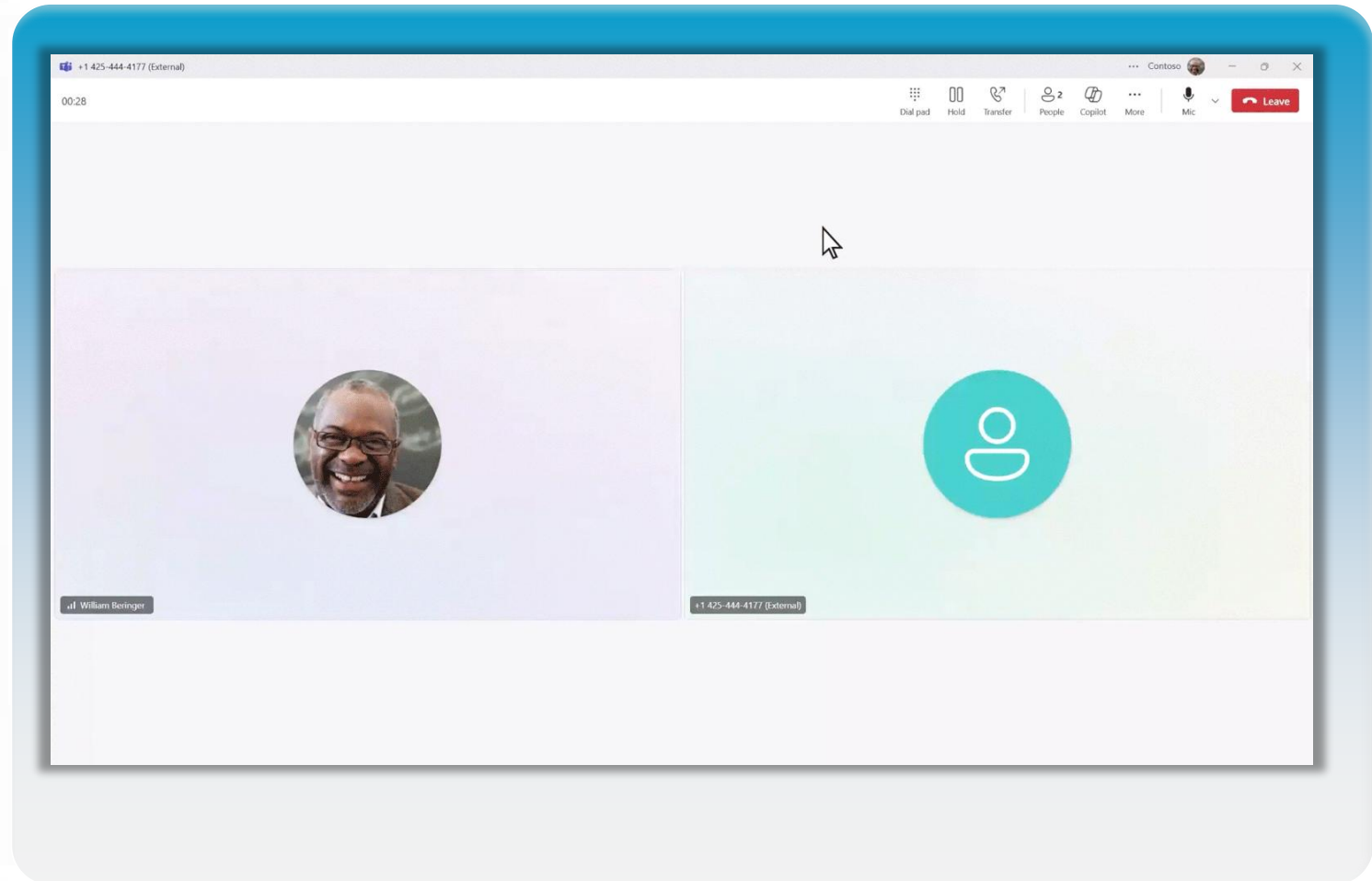
Use Copilot During Teams Calls Without Turning On Transcription Or Recording



Available now in

This new feature allows users to leverage Copilot's capabilities during live call sessions without retaining transcripts or an audio recording afterward.

This ensures that users can benefit from Copilot during sensitive conversations where a persistent record is not desired.

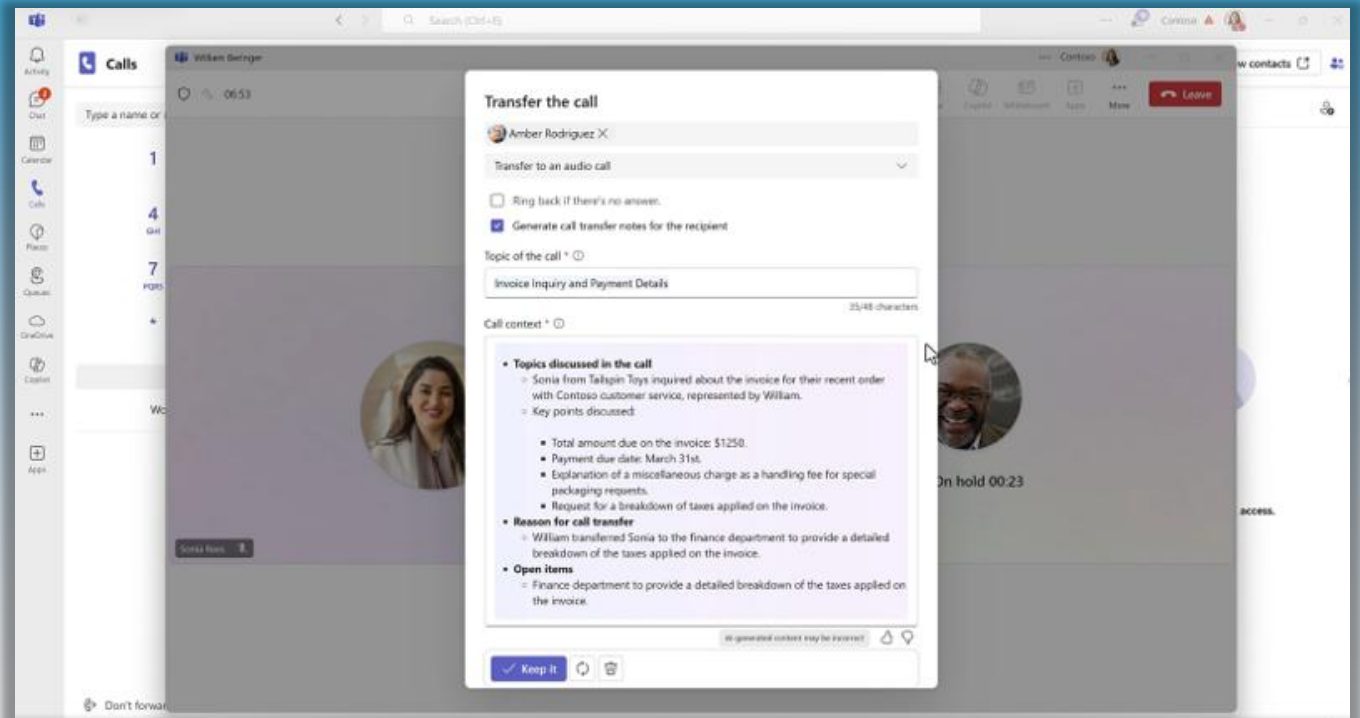
AI-Enhanced Call Transfers

Copilot uses AI to facilitate seamless transfers, ensuring smooth communication between colleagues.

Automated AI Call Notes

The feature allows users to request AI-generated notes summarizing the call, aiding the receiving colleague.

The summaries improve the recipient's understanding by providing context about previous conversations.



Microsoft Teams **Devices Updates**

Microsoft Teams desk phones - Teams app version: 1449/1.0.94.2025084203 (Poly, Yealink and Audiocodes)

- Line keys are now available on touch phone devices.
- Shared line history is now available on phone devices.
- You can now pin apps of your choice to your home screen using settings named “Home screen”. This is only available for touch phones.
- App also includes multiple bug fixes and improvements.
 - AOSP migration and back-end calendar fixes.
 - With this release, you will be able to resume held calls using a single entry.
 - Joining a meeting via dial-info on calendar is now fixed.
 - Deleted groups from People app will now sync across clients.
 - For non-touch phone devices, the Resume button will now be one of the four keys below the display. It can be triggered using the corresponding hard key on the device.
 - Issue on walkie talkie app and Teams channel is fixed.
 - Fixed auto-dial issue on emergency calls for non-touch devices.
 - Fixed issue on blind transfer for non-touch devices.
 - For Advanced calling experience on common area phones, issue on “Default to home screen” setting is fixed.

Unified Q&A Experience

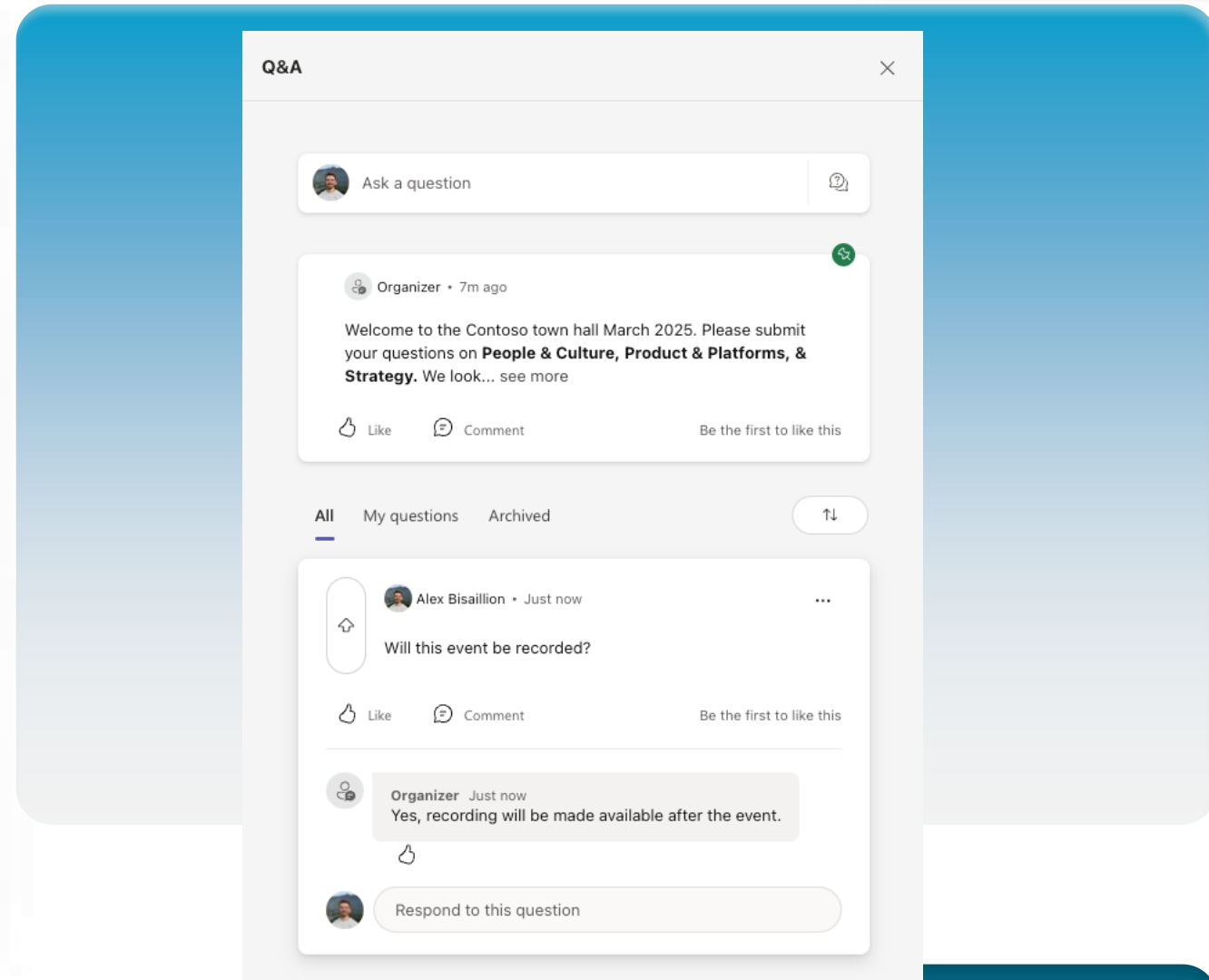
Organizers can answer questions collectively, enhancing the communication experience for attendees.

DVR Support for Town Hall



Generally available in April

DVR functionality allows attendees to interact with live town hall sessions like recorded content, enhancing engagement.

Attendees can pause, rewind, or fast-forward through the town hall content, making it easier to digest.

Viewers can navigate to any previously streamed timestamp, enhancing the convenience of content access.

Universal Availability

This DVR feature is available for all town halls, regardless of the license assigned to the organizers.



Town Hall Concurrent Attendee Increase to 50K

Increased Attendee Capacity

The maximum number of simultaneous attendees has increased from 20,000 to 50,000, allowing for broader reach.

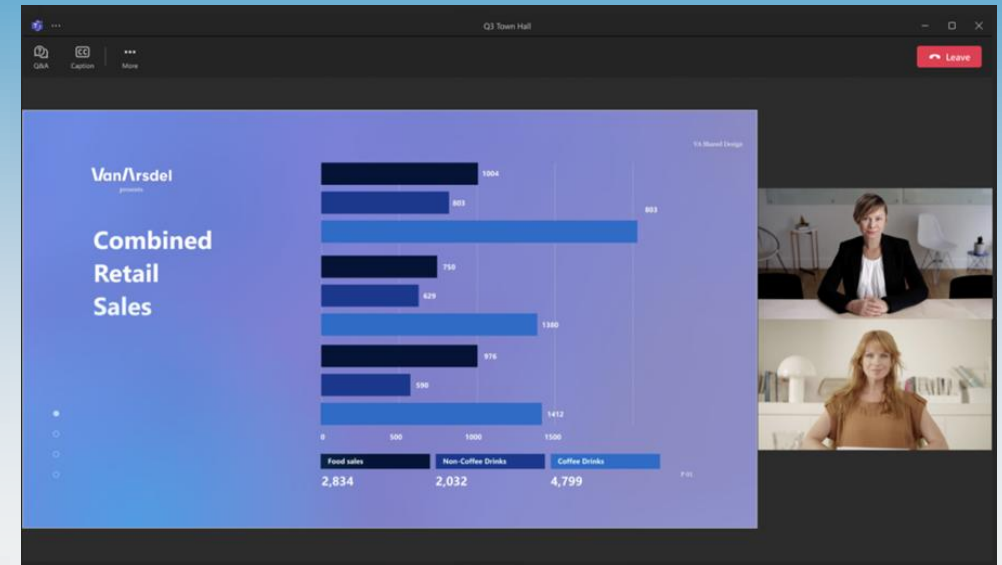
Interactivity Features Update

For events with over 20,000 attendees, some interactivity features will be disabled to maintain performance.

1. Admins now have expanded device health signals with sign-on, Teams Rooms app heartbeat, and network status for Android devices, offering consistency across operating systems.

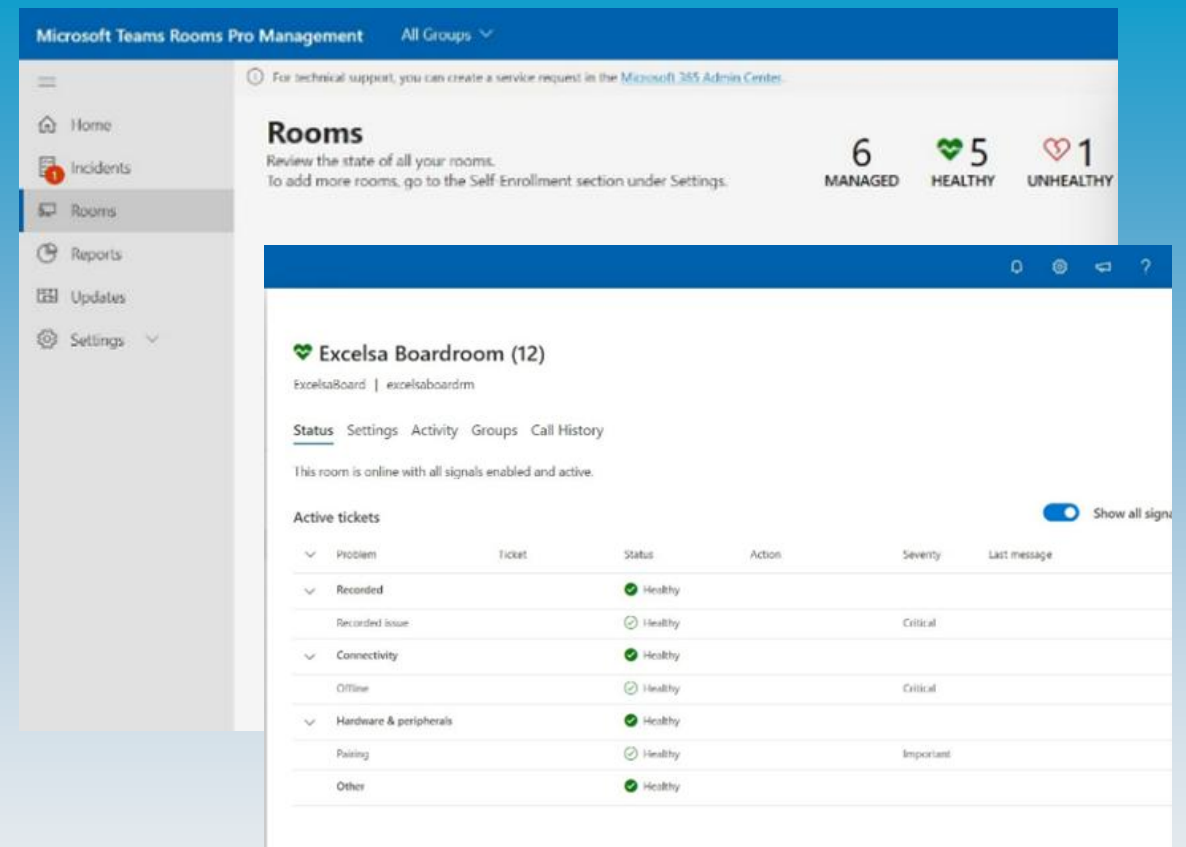
2. Unified Device Management:

- Consolidation of admin portals for Teams Rooms on Windows.
- Expanded access to Basic and Standard licensed rooms.
- Decommissioning of Teams admin center agent by end of April.
- Future inclusion of Teams Rooms on Android.

3. AI Assistant: Public preview available soon, providing quick product help and device-specific information.

4. GCC-H Customers: Pro Management service available in April, ensuring high security and privacy.

- Versions of the new Teams client that were released more than 90 days ago will be blocked. An in-app warning banner will show up 60 days before the app is blocked (30 days for VDI).

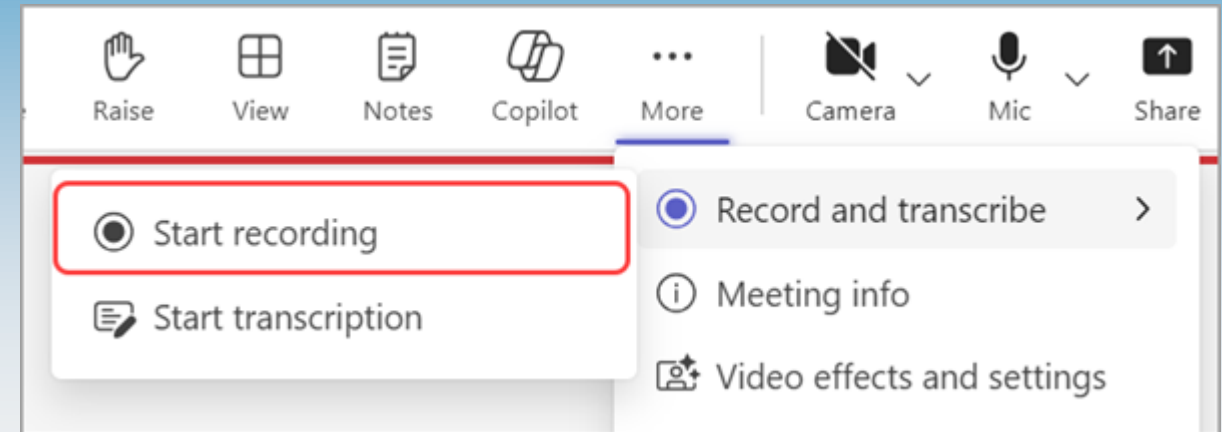
Separate Policies To Control Transcription & Recording For Town Halls & Webinars

Town halls and webinars now have separate policies from meetings to allow or disable transcription and recording in instances.

Previously, the transcription and recording policies for town halls and webinars automatically inherited the transcription and recording policy set for meetings.

Town hall and webinars can now also have distinct transcription and recording policies from each other. This option to implement different policies for town hall and webinars is available for users on all licenses.

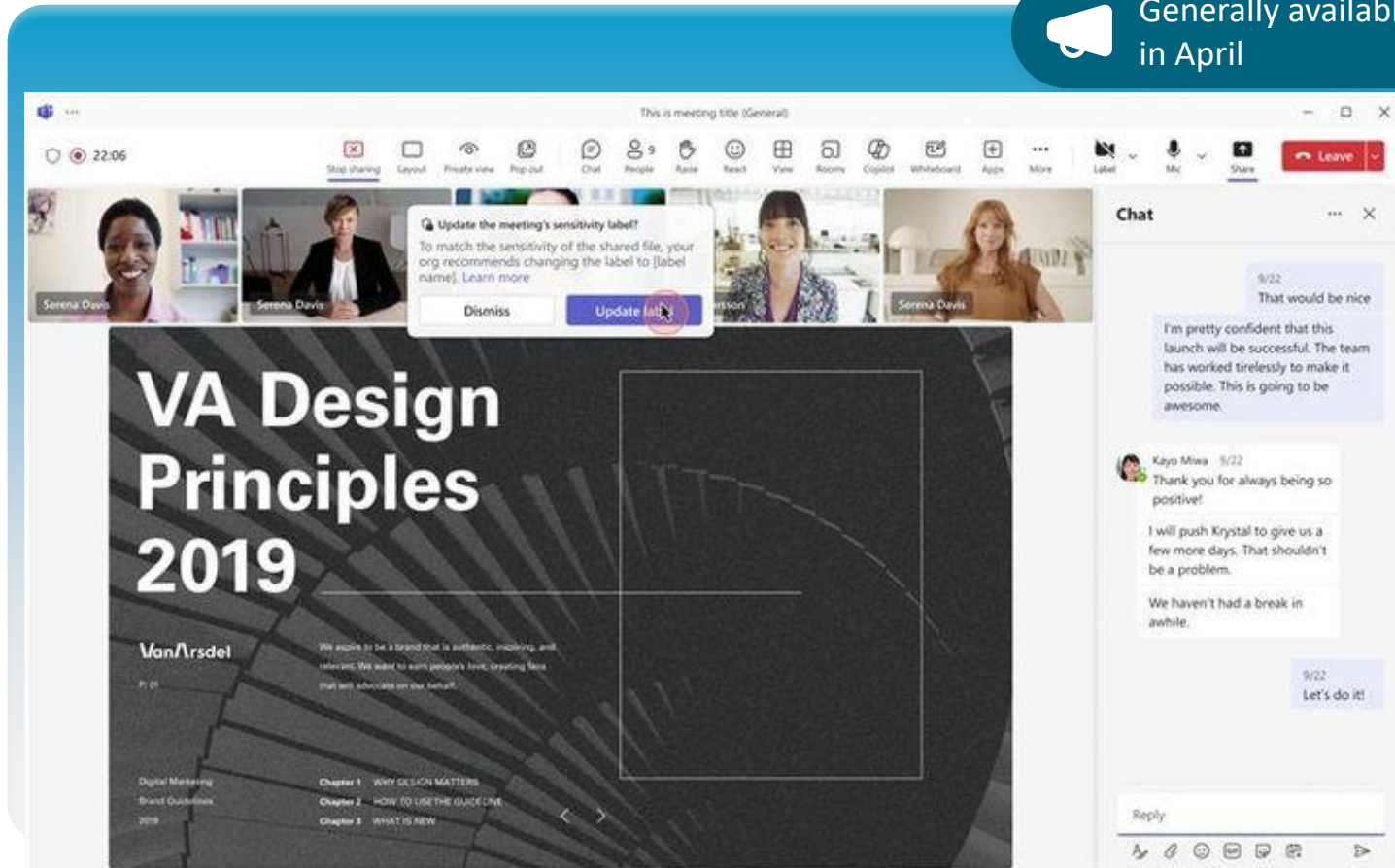
Auto-Upgrade Meeting Protection Based On Shared File: Sensitivity Label Inheritance [Premium]

Now Microsoft Teams can automatically upgrade the sensitivity level of a meeting based on the sensitivity of files shared during the meeting.

When an attendee shares a file with a higher sensitivity label, the meeting's protection settings are enhanced to match the file's sensitivity.

It requires an Microsoft 365 E5 and Teams Premium license with Purview enabled.

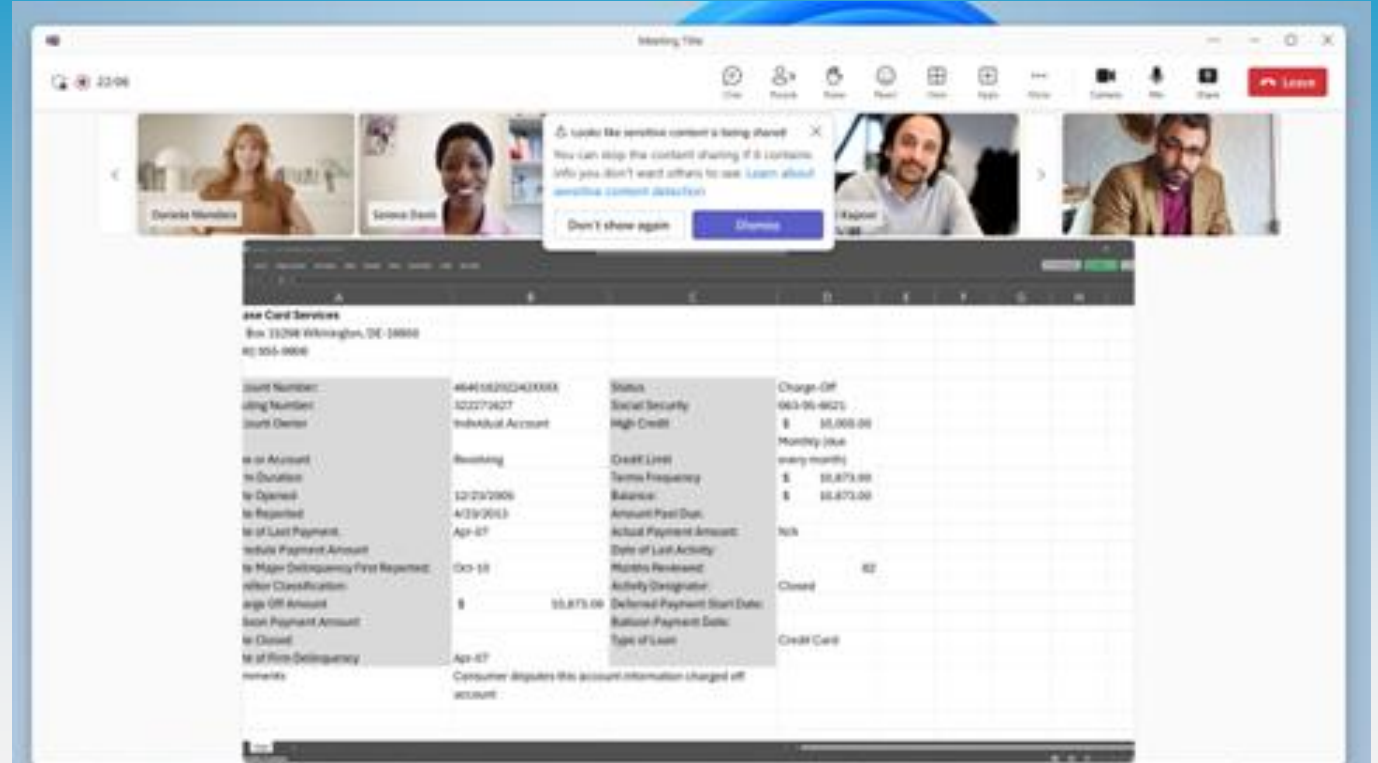
Active Meeting Protection: Detect Sensitive Content While Screensharing & Notify [Premium]

Generally available

This new feature enhances security during meetings by using AI to automatically detect potentially sensitive information, such as social security numbers and credit card numbers, during screen sharing.

When such content is detected, the feature alerts both the presenter and the meeting organizer to prevent unintentional sharing.

This feature is available to meeting organizers who have Teams Premium.
