SHL Pharma (SHL) is a privately held medical device fabrication company based in Deerfield Beach, FL. SHL released a RFP to vendors to assist with developing a new product manufacturing plant at 3471 Trade Center Ct. North Charleston, SC. The expectation of this plant will be to fulfill the efficiencies experienced throughout other facilities and maximize production.

In partnership with Network controls, eGroup | Enabling Technologies were awarded the bid to buildout the datacenter for this new facility.

SOLUTION

SHL Pharma's interior fit up of the plant will house a production facility with injection molding machines, conveyor system, a Quality Assurance Control Lab, various amenity spaces that service the plant, logistics and warehousing areas, multiple mezzanines providing equipment structures & potentially offices. Although the facility is not a "clean room" by definition, it will be required to be quite dust free.
