# **CHALLENGE**

Georgia Department of Early Care Learning utilizing SCCM for patch management and was too much to manage manually with Configuration Manager. They wanted to move away from this to Intune and use Autopilot for managing laptops, iPads, & Surface Tablets. Georgia Department of Early Care Learning also wanted to deploy Defender for Endpoint on 1,000 endpoint devices and set security policies and restrictions for servers.

#### **SOLUTION**

The Implementation phase will be conducted following a PDS+Pilot. This phase will build from the previous and starts to create the policies, rules, behaviors, and alerts decided upon in Phase 1. eG | ET will assess the existing MDE configuration and implement recommended changes. The engagement culminates with a hand-off deliverable. AOCM Services include impact analysis, user communication plan, training plan, and train the trainer services.

### **OUTCOMES**

eG | ET will provide Georgia Department of Early Care Learning with As-Built handoff documentation upon completion of the deployment with PDS + Pilot for MDE and Intune Autopilot. Then, the project will move onto Phase II for a full deployment and 1-year support with both workloads.
