CHALLENGE

Pexco's manual imaging processes for desktops were time-consuming and prone to errors. Managing workstations and mobile devices through various third-party tools and MSPs resulted in fragmented systems, making it difficult to maintain consistency and security across the organization. They were seeking a comprehensive solution that could automate imaging processes, integrate workstation and mobile device management, and reduce reliance on external service providers.

SOLUTION
