Towne Park received strategic advisory findings, envisioning documentation, and a comprehensive Planning & Design roadmap. The pilot rollout included up to three DLP policies and two Information Protection policies with up to five labels each, along with as-built documentation for IT. The engagement established a strong, scalable foundation for compliant, secure, and AI-ready data governance, maximizing the value of Towne Park's 1,400 E5 Compliance licenses.
