CHALLENGE

A venture capitalist group purchased Kenco to continue their rapid growth through acquisitions. One group that was separate from the purchase was their forklift division, which needed to be divested from their environment. Kenco called upon eGroup | Enabling Technologies to help them with their divestment and separation of Toyota Material Handling South's (TMHS) IT assets.
