<p>The Manatee County Sheriff's Office sought to implement a comprehensive Microsoft 365 project, including planning, design, pilot deployment, and migration. To achieve this, they engaged eGroup Enabling Technologies for expert assistance and guidance throughout the process.</p>	<p>The project was executed through a structured four-phase approach:</p> <p><b>Assessment &amp; Planning</b> - This phase involved a comprehensive analysis of the current configurations and usage patterns. Policies were determined, unique configurations were reviewed, and detailed migration plans were drafted.</p> <p><b>Configuration &amp; Testing</b> - During this phase, migration configurations and testing setups were established. This included setting up migration tooling, scripting activities, conducting end-to-end testing, and finalizing the migration plans.</p> <p><b>Migration, Validation, &amp; Support</b> - This final phase encompassed executing the production migrations, validating data integrity and cutover results, and providing support for any issues that arose during the cutover process.</p> <p><b>OneDrive Sync Client Deployment</b> - Additionally, advisory sessions were conducted to detail the process required to integrate the OneDrive Sync Client into the existing M365 apps installation.</p>	<p>Manatee County Sheriff's Office successfully completed the Planning, Design, Pilot Deployment, and Production Migration for Exchange Online, OneDrive, and Entra ID with eGroup Enabling Technologies.
